Aim of project: Better understanding of the respective differences among practices of the ID5 Offices.

Phase 1: Preliminary study of legal provisions and practices regarding product indications.

- •Role of product indication in the invalidation of designs

Phase 2: Upon completion of the comparative study the Partners will assess the results of it and proceed to recommendations on an appropriate model for the development of a uniform product indication database.

Modification of the existing classification systems.

Creation of a taxonomy to complement the existing classification.

01 February 2017	The Partners submit the information required for the study. Deliverable: Contributions by Partners
31 March 2017	All information is compiled and distributed to the Partners by the Lead Office. Deliverable: compiled information by Lead Office
15 July 2017	Partners submit observations. Deliverable: Partners observations upon comparison of practices
30 September 2017	The Lead Office prepares final conclusions and distributes them to the Partners. Deliverable: Final conclusions of the study
Annual Meeting 2017	Approval of final conclusions by the Partners.
